

«Russia and the Contemporary World». About the Journal.

The aim of the journal is to analyze problems of Russian past, present and future and the interrelationships of these problems with contemporary global and regional context. The journal is multidisciplinary and interdisciplinary. It contains materials on the history, sociology, philosophy; political and economic sciences.

The journal "Russia and the contemporary world" is published quarterly (4 issues per year) by two institutions of the Russian Academy of Sciences — Institute of scientific information for social sciences (INION), the Institute of Economics (IE RAS) since 1993. Problematic and disciplinary perspectives of the journal are wide, including printed materials, political, sociological, historical, economic, illuminating the present and the past of Russia, its role and place in contemporary world, especially social development, relations with other states and peoples. The reader gets acquainted with these materials primarily under the headings "Russia: yesterday, today and tomorrow" and "Russia and the world in the XXI century". The last category also includes studies of global processes and development of countries whose experience is important for Russia. We also publish abstracts and reviews of foreign literature on key aspects of global processes.

The journal strives to reflect the readers' interest in the activities of the organizations and individuals who have left an appreciable trace in Russian history, significant events in the modern scientific and cultural life (we also have sections "Facts, events, people" and "Scientific and cultural life"). Archival and little-known publications of scientists and political figures of the past, devoted to the problems that continues to be important today, are placed under the headline "Classical heritage".

You can find the content of the journal and abstracts of the main articles at the end of each number. They are given in Russian and English languages.

The journal is recommended by the Higher attestation Commission (VAK) of the Ministry of education and science of the Russian Federation and included in "the List of leading reviewed scientific journals and editions", which publishes the main results of doctoral and candidate dissertations in four scientific disciplines: political science, sociology, philosophy, cultural studies.
